# Vice President & Child Safety Officer Report

## Fundraising Efforts

Well, it is safe to say the 2020 season was like no other. Plenty of preparation made for a belated start to the season just before the second wave of COVID-19 hit. All players, coaches, team managers and parents were wound up like coiled springs ready to jump into the first round in mid-July and then we got smacked back into hard lockdown.

There has been some saving grace with the SMJFL “Footy for Fun” program which has kept kids engaged in football.

Our fundraising team did some wonderful work early on in the year to get ready to promote the “Head Space” program, which is an Australian non-profit organisation for youth mental health established by the Australian Government in 2006. We acquired bright green jumpers to be used in this fundraising drive. Unfortunately because we could not take the field in the main season, we were unable to raise funds for this worthy cause.

However, Season 2021 will be bigger and better than ever. We hope to deploy the green jumpers in our older age groups across both boys’ and girls’ teams.

## Child Safety

This remains our primary focus at the Knights. Our children play football because they love it but we must ensure that they are kept safe whilst doing it.

Our members responded exceptionally well in maintaining compliance with Working with Children Checks (**WWCC**). The SMJFL maintains a vigilant position in this regard, extending the requirements for timekeepers to have a WWCC. We stand shoulder-to-shoulder with the SMJFL in this regard and guard our “zero-tolerance” policy jealously with respect to Child Safety. As a Club we need to promote as many of our members as possible to obtain their WWCC to ensure that we have enough helpers on match day.

In my first year as Vice President I have been delighted to become better acquainted with our Club Chaplain, Vicki Mustafa. Vicki was always on hand to assist wherever possible but given the restrictions placed on us by COVID-19, it was very difficult for her to engage with the Club in a practical sense but we were always in her thoughts.

We look forward to Vicki’s support in 2021.

Whilst in many ways Season 2020 was less than auspicious, it can only embolden us for a fantastic 2021.

## Secretary's Report

Thanks to a little thing known as COVID-19, Season 2020 was never meant to be. Over 840 Knights players across 40 teams were all raring to go after Victoria came out of its first lockdown, albeit with a reduced season. COVID safety plans were firmly in place, then a couple of days before kick-off, the rug was pulled from under us when Victoria went back into strict lockdown.

Many weeks later, there was a small light at the end of the tunnel & the SMJFL & Clubs worked furiously to pull together some semblance of a season & Footy for Fun was born. Based on AFL 9's, this consisted of 10 players playing a "keepings off" style of footy (if the footy touches the ground, it is a turnover & the other team gets the ball). The Knights pulled together over 40 teams & the kids seemed to be having a lot of fun. The parents seemed even more excited than the kids given their children were finally off their devices, out in the fresh air & reconnecting with their mates. Our key focus of providing a safe environment for our kids & parents to enjoy football, supporting the development of our players and encouraging respect & integrity within the Knights community continues (with extra safety measures in place in the current COVID environment)

Club numbers were down slightly this year due to the uncertainty surrounding COVID, but we expect a strong bounce-back next year. We expect to have at least one U17.5 team for the first time in a number of years. Over 600 families chose to rollover their registration fee & a number of generous families also donated their rego fee to the club so we are poised for a strong start to 2021

In my third year in the club secretary role I have continued to work closely with the SMJFL & built on the previously established strong relationship. The team at the League were particularly impressed with & appreciative of the assistance we provided them in relation to Footy for Fun (finding them two Ground Managers (Rish & Nish), Trainers as well as providing them with a lot of equipment (defibs, stretchers, poles, cones etc))

A big thanks to all players, volunteers & parents who work together to make the club the wonderful club that it is. And many thanks to my fellow committee members for all their hard work over the year (including those non committee members who work "behind the scenes")...without their tireless efforts, we would not be the club that we are today. Although Footy for Fun was only for 4 weeks, it took almost as much work to pull together as a "normal" season!!

Looking forward playing lots & lots of footy in 2021!

# Department Reports

## EMJFC Football Department – Mick Hegan, Carl Callenbach and Julia Hay

The Football Department began its work for the 2020 season as soon as the 2019 finals series had concluded. By the end of the 2019 calendar year the following preparation had commenced:

- Coaching expressions of interest had been sought and many coaches appointed
- Debriefing with retiring coaches
- Reviews of players for the purposes of team balance and grading in certain age groups
- Nominations of players for St Kilda NGA and SMJFL Interleague purposes
- Appointment of specialist coaches including B&D Sports for kicking skills and Malcolm Bangs for tackling
- Appointing age group co-ordinators for each year level
- Timetables and venues for pre-season training
- Organisation of some pre-season games both internal and against external clubs including East Sandringham, St Peters & Ormond
- Accreditation from AFL for coaches
- Liaising with Malvern District Auskick regarding potential numbers for under 8's
- Updating the Football Policy
- Preparation had begun for the annual Mosman Swans Football trips

### Numbers and Recruiting

The 2020 season promised to be another year full of promise and enjoyment for all players, well so it seemed, enter stage left – COVID along with some very harsh restrictions, footy was cooked.

The club had retained a large percentage of existing players whilst also attracting many new players from outside the club. The team participation was to be 40 teams, down 1 from 2019. Refer table comparison next page.

The club continues to grow particularly in the girl's divisions. **We still maintain that we are the biggest and best junior AFL club in the world!** Whilst the traditional feeder primary schools in the local area (Malvern, Lloyd Street, St Marys, St Rochs and Caulfield Grammar) made up the majority of under 8-10 players, the club also began to welcome many new families from Solway primary and other schools for their first season with the famous Mighty Knights.

### Objectives of the Football Department

Our key objective is to create a safe, supportive and fun environment for all our players and families. Key objectives for 2020 continued to include:

- Maintain participation rates (I want to come back and play next year)
- Sportsmanship and fair play
- Environment and program that fosters learning (I learned my footy at the Knights)
- Build and maintain a strong sense of community (community club not school-based club)
- Develop players to transition into school, youth and then senior football
- Increase female participation on and off the field
- To improve the level of education for our coaches across all facets of the game

### Grading in 2020



Given recent experience, and consistent with clear expectations communicated by the SMJFL, the club intended to commence internal hard grading at under 12 mixed level in 2020 across two of the five u12 Mixed teams along with some soft grading of the three U11 Mixed teams.

### Summer Footy for fun

Just when we thought all was said and done, our beloved premier released the shackles to some extent and summer footy for fun was born. Yes! was the cry from many families involved not only with the Knights but also many other SMJFL clubs.

With the announcement that the SMJFL would organise and conduct a four-week footy summer series beginning on Sunday November 15, the club received just on 400 expressions of interest to participate from children ranging from u8s to Youth Girls.

For the record we lodged 30 teams. We shouldn't underestimate the amount of work that was undertaken to complete all necessary action items in a very short period of time which included, creating teams, finding coaches, umpires, ensuring WWCC were valid, zoom meetings, telephone calls, emails back and forth, organising appropriate gear to be handed out and so much more. It was an incredible effort to bring it altogether in a fortnight for the kids.

And girls represented also in the U8 & U9 mixed teams

All teams had participated in three to five training sessions before Covid hit, and unfortunately the season was at first postponed and then later cancelled.

Girls have had a strong representation in the mini series – run by the SMJFL, currently underway at the time of writing this report.

Knights did receive some fantastic news in the AFLW draft, having Abbi Maloney, Eliza McNamara and Winnie Laing drafted to AFLW clubs for the 2021 season. The club would like to recognise these players with a formal presentation in the 2021 season.

In 2021, the Knights look forward to establishing a sub-committee for girls at the club, to enhance our program by offering some specific training and development across the club for girls. The Knights would like to be recognised as a "hub" for female player development.

## EMJFC Football Operations – Shane Yole, Jonathan Brown, Patrick Charles

What do you write about 'Football Operations' in a year without football? Before the three of us took on the Footy Ops role for 2020, we were told that it was simple job (working under the guiding hand of the Footy Department) – a bit of hard work before the first games, then cruise through the year, and hard work collecting the kit back... well 2020 delivered everything except the games.

Planning for the year went exceptionally well – we had recruited Rishabh Kothari's brother Nish as a second ground manager, with 3 members of the team (and exceptional support from Mick and Simon for planning) we were very confident of the year ahead. Prior to the season's nominal commencement, line marking had been arranged, all equipment distributed, and additional COVID-Safe measures planned and ready for implementation... just in time for the season being cancelled on the Tuesday prior to Round 1.

COVID-19 had already put some additional challenges in our preparations for First Aid / CPR training, but we managed to organize and complete training for all relevant volunteers before the start of the year – a VERY challenging task, but one which meant that EMJFC was ready with trained staff in all roles. We also arranged for 2 additional webinars to be held for trainers and coaches (A concussion

session with Peter Growse, and injury prevention with return to sport with Laura Scott and Sarah Yule) – these sessions were recorded (Thanks Jules Hay!) and made available to those who were unable to be in the live event. These sessions were excellent, and will be held again in 2021.

After serious delays in getting access to our storage prior to the season, when we did finally manage to get access, we were greeted by the remnants of 45 first aid kits which had been ransacked by the local rat population (trying to get to the jelly beans) – and the resultant droppings which were deposited in multiple kits. Jono cleaned out the store-room, Shane organized new kits, Simon got the jerseys washed, and Caz organized the insurance – the end result being new first aid kits for all teams, and we were able to but ‘rat gate’ behind us... although Shane now has an obsession with rat bait, and Jono with lockable plastic tubs. With the support of the Committee, we now also have defibrillators for both pavilions, and one for the Ground Manager.

The organization, distribution, and (after a non-existent season) return of all kit was greatly enhanced by the storage solutions organized by the 2019 Committee – although we are still waiting on the additional storage space to be released by Stonington Council. The shelving setup made the organization of equipment significantly easier than it had been previously. This was especially the case when after the aborted season, the SMJFL launched footy 4 fun – which then required the distribution of sanitizer and footballs to some 30 teams. Within the Footy Ops team, Patrick in particular has done a power of work with the incidental ‘distribution and collection’ of equipment in 2020.

The Footy Ops team for 2021 will include both Patrick and Jono returning, but we will be saying goodbye (and thanks) to Shane for all his efforts – especially first-aid training/kits/rat bait, and his absolute willingness to help whenever needed. We are hopeful that at least one other member will be recruited into the team for next year.

We owe an enormous debt of gratitude to:

- Mick Hegan for his organization, support, and guidance in both his role as Football Department, and also as an exceptional human being.
- Simon Bell who escaped Footy Ops for the much easier role of President during a global Pandemic, and in addition to all logistical support, was ever-present at footy ops working bees.
- Caz Beadle – the voice of reason and font of knowledge on all things EMJFC.
- The rest of the committee for their assistance and support... we could say something nice about everyone!

It is hard to give advice to future years on the basis of 2020... but in short, the planning for 2020 has set us up well for 2021, we expect to have a well organized equipment (and merchandise) store in place for 2021 – which will make distribution and collection even easier than it has been. A determined clean-out of old equipment (especially footballs) also means we are no longer burdened by unwanted/unneeded equipment taking up space in the store. Organization of training was well managed in 2020, and a clear plan/timetable will be in place for the 2021 season. We expect to retain both Rish and Nish as ground managers, and are really looking forward to actually having the kids play footy in 2021!
